Provenance

When Hailama Farden became a Hawaiian Language teacher at Kamehameha Schools, Kapalama, in 1992, he said that he found the trophy in his classroom. The name "B. Farden" inscribed on the trophy was his granduncle, Bernard, who was the captain of the 1922 championship Track and Field Team. Bernard donated the original team photograph to Kamehameha Schools. Hailama and Bernard's grand- daughter, Cathy "Holo" Stephens Ralar polished the trophy before bringing it to the Kamehameha Schools Museum Archive, then called Kamehameha Schools Archives.

The collection was processed in the 1990s. A bibliographic record was electronically created according to APPM in 2004 and according to DACS in 2005.

* Although "E.Hohu" is inscribed on the trophy, the team photo seems to tell a different story. Edmund K. Hohu is in dress uniform at the top of the photograph behind a man who must be their coach. Half Mile Relay team members are seated in the front row of the photograph. Clarence K. Hohu is seated between two relay team members. Circumstantial photographic evidence seems to imply that Clarence K., not Edmund K. was a member of the winning relay team.
