Community Service Guidelines

10 hours of community service

Required for Po'okula, Ka'i Lanakila, and Nowelo scholarship recipients

- Complete your ten (10) hours of community service hours beginning **July 1, 2023** through **June 30, 2024**.
- Any practicum hours that you completed and are covered by this KS College scholarship program cannot be used to satisfy your community service requirement.
- If you do not meet the Community Service requirement in this current year (2023-2024), it can result in your award being cancelled or rescinded for subsequent academic years, if applicable.
- Community service may be performed with multiple organizations.
- Community service must meet the following criteria:
 - /// Be performed with a non-profit organization
 - /// Be unpaid
 - /// Does not benefit a KS student, staff, or programs.
 - /// Does not benefit political campaigns, programs, or parties.
 - /// Required internship and practicum hours will not be accepted. However, hours in excess of your internship and practicum may be reported as community service as long as the activities meet all other guideline criteria.
- Record and submit your community service hours on the [Community Service Portal](#) starting on **August 1, 2023**.
- Note: Students are encouraged to perform service within their own community for an organization that benefits a Native Hawaiian, indigenous, or under-served population.
